The home inspection training course will prepare students with the knowledge and experience needed to successfully complete and pass state and national certification exams. Students will understand the entire home inspection process from the beginning to the very end, including what to do before the inspection, arriving at the site, all aspects and procedures during the inspection, communication of the findings and reporting of those findings. The student will also be trained on inspecting every aspect of the house from the roof to the foundation and all systems in between. Since all houses are different and there are multiple variations on heating/cooling systems, ventilation, electric, roofs, etc, students will gain in-depth knowledge of those variations to provide proper inspection and procedure. Completion of this course will provide students with the ability to advance their career in home inspection as well as start their own business.
